A Bible Learning program for 3rd - 6th graders, supported by the volunteer efforts of parents/guardians, B.L.O.C. Team (Building Lives on Christ - a senior high ministry program) ministry staff, and pastors.

Welcome to the Good News Bearers (GNB) program! If you are new to this ministry, here is some general information about the program. The program is run primarily through the volunteer efforts of the B.L.O.C. Team and parents, as well as other interested church members, with support from ministry staff and pastors. *Without consistent volunteer help, the program would not continue to be the success it's been for the last 12 years. Parent/guardian presence and involvement is needed on a weekly basis.*

Help required that you please sign up for one of the following:

Meal Teams - a more extensive orientation to the kitchen & tasks of these positions will be provided.

- û Serve as a Meal Team Captain, heading up the group of people who prepare a meal once a month and serving the prepared meal with them. As Meal Team Captain you may also need to give direction to the weekly kitchen help.
- û Serve on one of four meal teams, helping prepare a meal once each month. Responsibilities of this position include: call to ask for food or monetary donations, purchase and prepare food (meal and lemonade/coffee), serve food, label leftovers and freeze, complete weekly records such as food count, cash sheet and expense sheet, launder used towels and return them to church.

Kitchen Help - check in with the Meal Team Captain at 5:30 - work until approximately 7 pm:

If you do not sign up to be part of a meal team, please check this box - you are automatically assigned to kitchen help. Responsibilities of this position include: serve meal if needed, scrape dishes, soak silverware and run through dishwasher, put away dishes, sweep floor and mop with Clorox (this must be done to meet county health codes), take out garbage, launder used towels and return them to church. *Carrying out your Kitchen Help role as assigned is vital to the smooth operation of the weekly meal.* Kitchen help duties are rotated; families (not on a meal team) will end up with more than one turn as kitchen help and EVERYONE is needed each week to help with washing and taking down tables, putting up dividers, etc.

FYI - All families enrolling children in the GNB program will be asked to donate a food item or monetary equivalent a minimum of two times during the year, depending upon enrollment numbers.
